- CGPA 10 (with upgradation) &- 9.8(without upgradation)-75% scholarship.
- CGPA 9.8(with upgradation) & 9.6(without upgradation)- 50% scholarship .

### **For ISCE Students-**

- 93% & above Full scholarship.
- 90%--92% 75% scholarship.
