Grade: Nursery


Age Criteria - 2 - 3 years

Participant: 1 student

Duration: 40 minutes

Theme: Autumn Festivals

- Participants are required to colour a picture using their colouring skills.
- Students must carry crayons with them.
- Students will receive an A4 sheet containing a picture to colour on the spot.
- They must not use any other resources.

Event Name- The Finger Palette

Grade: Nursery

Age Criteria - 2 - 3 years

Participants: 1 student

Duration: 40 minutes

Theme: Autumn Festivals

- Participants are required to create an art work using finger painting techniques.
- Students must carry their own ink pads or washable water colours.
- They will receive an A4 sheet with the picture on the spot.
- They must not use any other resources.

Event Name- Book Buddy

Grade: LKG

Age Criteria: 3-4 years

Participants: 1 student

Duration: 40 minutes

Theme: Autumn Festivals

- Participants are required to make one bookmark.
- Participants are free to make bookmarks of any shape and style.
- The size of the bookmark must not exceed 10 inches.
- They can use crayons, sketch pens, colour pencils and decorative materials.
- Participants must carry their own material.

Event Name- Clay Critters

Grade: LKG

Age Criteria: 3 - 4 years

Participants: 1 Student

Duration: 1 hour

Theme: Autumn Festivals

- Participants are required to make a Clay Magnet.
- Students can use decorative materials. However, they are expected to mould the clay and not use stencils or shapes during the competitions.
- Participants can use creative material to design the magnet.
- Participants must carry their own material.

Grade:UKG

Age Criteria: 4-5 years

Participants: 1 Student

Duration: 40 minutes

Theme: Autumn Festivals

- Participants need to use their creativity to decorate the diyas.
- Medium-Sized diyas will be provided on the spot.
- Participants must carry their own acrylic paints, and any decorative items to decorate the diyas.

- Participants are required to create a Lantern or lamp on the given theme.
- Participants can use colored sheets, flowers, and other decorative material such as mirrors, lace, etc.
- Participants must carry their own material.

Grade: I

Age Criteria: 5-6 years

Participant: 1 Student

Duration: 1 hour

Theme: Autumn Festivals

- Participants are required to draw and colour a scene depicting any festival of India.
- A-3 size sheet will be provided on the spot.
- Participants must carry their own pencils, colour pencils, crayons, paints and markers.

Event Name- Brush & Bubbles


Grade: I

Age Criteria: 5-6 years

Participant: 1 Student

Duration: 1 hour

- Participants are required to create canvas abstract painting using masking tape and water colours
- They must use an A-4 size base
- Students must bring a Canvas board with the design imprinted on it with the help of the masking tape.
- Participants will colour the canvas on the spot using water colours.
- They must not use any other resources.
- Participants must carry their own material.





Event Name- Chitra Kala

Grade: II

Age Criteria: 6-7 years

Participants: 1 Student

Duration: 1 hour

- Participants are required to create a Festival scene through Warli Art using colours
 of their choice
- A-4 size sheet will be provided on the spot.
- They can use pencils, colour pencils, crayons, paints, sketch pens and markers.
- Participants must carry their own material.

Grade: II

Age Criteria: 6 - 7 years

Participant: 1 participant

Duration: 1 hour

Theme: Autumn Festivals

- Partcipants can use coloured sheets, colours, sketch pens, crayons and any other decoration material.

Grade: II

Age Criteria: 6 - 7 years

Participants: 1 Student

- Participants are required to make a 3D doll on the given theme using any medium as jute, paper, wool etc. and colours of their choice

- The size of the doll must not exceed 12 inches.
- Participants are allowed to use pre-cut bottles, cans and cloth to make a doll.
- Participants must carry their own material.
