- **Refreshments will be provided** inside the Parliament. However, students may carry light snacks and a water bottle for the bus journey only.
- **Bags are not permitted** inside the Parliament premises.
- Interested students to make the payment via ERP by **12/04/26** and submit the consent to the class teachers.
- Parents are expected to drop their ward to school in the morning and pick them up at the time of dispersal. The school will keep you updated with the return timings.
