

Subject: Implementation of CBSE Three-Language Policy & Introduction of Mathematics Advanced and Science Advanced for Grade IX (Session 2026–27)

Dear Parents,
Greetings!

In accordance with the latest CBSE guidelines under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the following academic structure will be implemented for **Grade IX** from the Academic Session **2026–27**.

1. Three-Language Policy

The language structure for Grade IX will be as follows:

- **R1:** English
- **R2:** Hindi / Sanskrit / German
- **R3:** As per the provision by CBSE
 - Students studying **Hindi** as R2 will study **Sanskrit** as R3.
 - Students studying **Sanskrit or German** as R2 shall study Hindi as R3.
 - Students who had **Spanish** as II Language will study Hindi as R2 and Sanskrit as R3.

As a **one-time transitional arrangement**, students who have opted for German may continue to study German for the current academic session, in accordance with CBSE guidelines. The **third language (R3)** will be assessed through **internal school-based assessment only**, and there will be **no CBSE Board Examination** in R3 for the current Grade IX batch.

2. Introduction of Advanced Mathematics & Advanced Science

To provide enhanced academic opportunities and prepare students for higher studies and competitive examinations, the CBSE is introducing **Mathematics Advanced** and **Science Advanced** for interested Grade IX students.

Parents are requested to carefully consider these options in consultation with their ward before making a choice at the time filling the registration with the CBSE.

Parents are requested to review these documents prior to the Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) scheduled on 18 July 2026. During the PTM, they may seek clarification regarding any queries and will also have the opportunity to confirm their ward's preferences, wherever applicable.
